Riga Circus is a multifunctional arts centre that deliberately works towards offering relevant and current circus shows to wider audiences. The building was built in 1888 and can be considered one of the oldest circus-focused buildings in Europe.

11. Novembra Krastmala

11 November Embankment is one of the most well known streets in Riga. Dating back to 19th century, this place has a lot of heritage buildings including the Riga Castle.
